Connecting woodworkers with locally produced material

The Local Food movement has driven the growth of small farms and farmer's markets across the country. Local markets are thronged with buyers looking for the best and freshest produce. Locally sourced and sustainably harvested lumber products provide the same level of benefits to the producer and to the consumer. Local wood products have much less environmental impact than imported materials, and the economic benefits of supporting local businesses are significant. Creating a local lumber movement requires a similar level of commitment and coordination between suppliers, craftsmen and consumers.

The goal of this conference is to explore the opportunities and identify the ways in which suppliers, craftsmen and advocates can work together to create a local lumber movement. What is it that craftsmen need from suppliers? Where do builders find locally produced millwork and interior finishes? How do we support a consistent supply of materials from local well managed forests?

The seminar brings together local wood suppliers, craftsmen and wood product manufacturers to explore the benefits and opportunities for using locally sourced wood. Vendors will showcase lumber products from local small woodland owners, small mills and small manufacturers.
