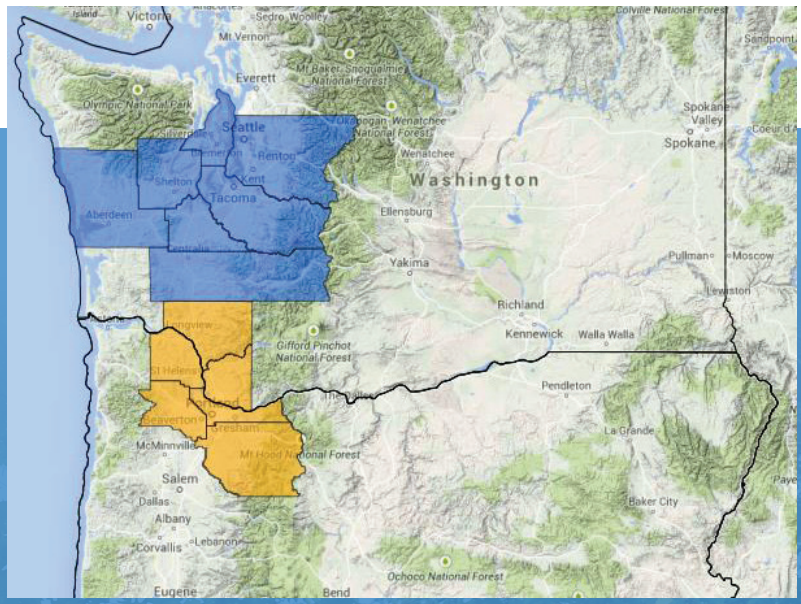

So make sure to contact NRCS today!

You may be eligible for financial and technical assistance from the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) to help you develop a forest management plan—a road map to help you achieve your resource conservation goals—and receive an initial carbon assessment and a carbon inventory, which measures how much carbon your forest is storing. NRCS offers reimbursement for installing conservation practices that will make your woods healthier, such as pre-commercial thinning, tree and shrub establishment, and more. Plus, at the same time, your woods can sequester additional carbon from the air, which helps to lessen the impacts of climate change and could potentially result in payments from the sale of carbon credits.
