

Tour Stops

Stop 1 - Mt. Adams Community Forest, South Conboy Tract - will discuss community forest management for multiple objectives on former industrial timberlands.

Stop 2 - USFWS and Mt. Adams Resource Stewards - will emphasize cross-boundary management involving commercial harvests and reintroduction of fire in ponderosa dominated stands.

Stop 3 - Lunch at Conboy Lake NWR Headquarters - will include a presentation from East Cascades Oak Partnership.

Stop 4 - Gifford Pinchot National Forest and Washington DNR – will highlight the Good Neighbor Authority; South Gifford Pinchot Collaborative Group
